A CAUTION:

Guard against injury from flying pieces of metal; wear goggles or safety glasses.

IMPORTANT:

Angle the drift toward the bucket to avoid damaging the rubber pin lock.

Check bucket teeth periodically so that wear does not extend to the bucket tooth shank.

- 1. Use a hammer and drift to drive out locking pin.
- 2.

Alternate buckets may use different tooth assemblies.

Remove tooth.

NOTE:

- 3. Inspect rubber pin lock (A) for damage. Replace if necessary.
- 4. If rubber pin lock has moved, reposition in slot in adapter tooth shank.
- 5. Position the new tooth over the tooth shank.
- 6. Drive the locking pin into the hole fully.
