
- D Fan Cover

Disconnect the Battery. SeeS900 - Battery Cut-off Switchin section 40, Group 05.




- 2. Remove the four screws (A).

- 4. Loosen knurled-head screw (C).



Remove screw (A) and (B) and disconnect refrigerant line (C) and (D); seal the openings so that they are air-tight.

- 6. Remove four screws (E).
- 7. Lift up the fans cover (F) and remove the condenser (G).
- 8. Clean condenser (G) with compressed air or water. Straighten any bent fins.

CAUTION:

Reduce compressed air pressure to less than 210 kPa (2 bar) (30 psi) when using for cleaning purposes. Clear area of bystanders, guard against flying chips, and wear personal protection equipment including eye protection.

- 9. Check that the condenser (G) is intact. Replace if necessary.
- 10. Install all parts in reverse order.
